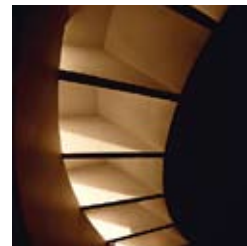

Local music and curious guests, but also great experiences meet each other during a couple of intense winter days in Mariehamn. The annual festival has been arranged since 2000. The festival continues according to its earlier pattern and focuses on young Nordic music artists.

Mariehamn Winter Jazz has developed into a winter event of class, and the Ålandic jazz scene has grown. The festival features many young talents, including music students Jochum Juslin and Victor Abrahamsson who together with young Swedish co-musicians feature the latest tunes in the continuously changing jazz music.

The extended co-operation with several other Nordic winter jazz events has resulted in several high-class soloists and artists arriving from our neighbouring countries. The winners of the jazz competition Young Nordic Jazz Comets 2009 – Reginfirra from Iceland, tuba-based trio PELbO from Norway, and the Danish YNJC-winners Surf in Stereo – are all coming to Mariehamn!

The major names of the two jazz evenings held at Alandica Culture & Congress Centre are the two vocalists who have already gained wide recognition; Johanna Grüssner with her Swedish band, and Emma Salokoski with Ilmiliekki Quartet, the young Nordic jazz masters of 2004.

ÅLAND SEA DAYS

13–18 JULY

The Åland Sea Days is a big annual marine event that takes place mainly in the Maritime Quarter, in Mariehamn's Eastern Harbour, but also on the museum-ship Pommern, in Degerby in Föglö, and at Lemström's Canal Party. The Sea Days offer a meeting-point for traditional wooden ships and motor craft, tourists and local people alike, as well as one of Åland's greatest music events with dance to live music in the evenings.

You can join races for traditional archipelago sailing or motor boats, handicraft demonstrations, children's activities and folk music get-togethers, or visit a handicraft market, see traditional sailors' craft, listen to shanties, or just take a cup of coffee and breathe in the tar-scented atmosphere.

There are also short daily sailing tours on the galleass Albanus and schooner Linden. The race for traditional sailing vessels is on the 14th of July from Degerby on Föglö to the Maritime Quarter. Ships will gather at Degerby on the 13th of July where it will be live music in bars and cafés at night.

BOMARSUND DAYS

7–8 AUGUST

Visit the Bomarsund Days and the 19th century Åland. This year the folk market is arranged for the seventh time, once again with a wide ranged programme for the whole family.

As a result of the defeat of the 1808–1809 war, Åland became the Russian empire's westernmost outpost against Sweden. To defend their western boarder, the Russians built a fortress in Bomarsund. The giant fortress would host 5,000 soldiers and 500 cannons, but it was blown up by British and French troops when it was only halfway finished. Before its defeat Bomarsund was the most multicultural place in Åland where people from the entire Russian empire lived side by side – Greek-Orthodoxies, Protestants, Catholics, Jews and Muslims.

This year's market lets you experience the fate of the fortress, from birth to defeat. Here you can learn about the people, civilians and soldiers whose destinies were connected to the fortress, and about the seed of peace that throughout the cannon smoke and blood developed into the demilitarisation of Åland. Let the performances and artists make your imagination fly, and don't miss the crafts and local delicacies of the market tables.

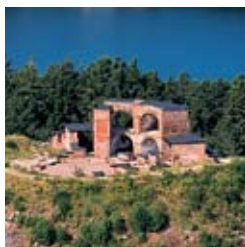

Be prepared to get tempted by local delicacies and meals that you can enjoy in the shadow of the old chestnut tree.

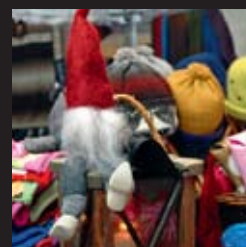
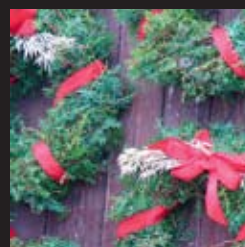
