On the way back on **Day 4**, you can stay overnight in **Godby** (additional charge) to have a chance to see more of the sights in **Sund**.

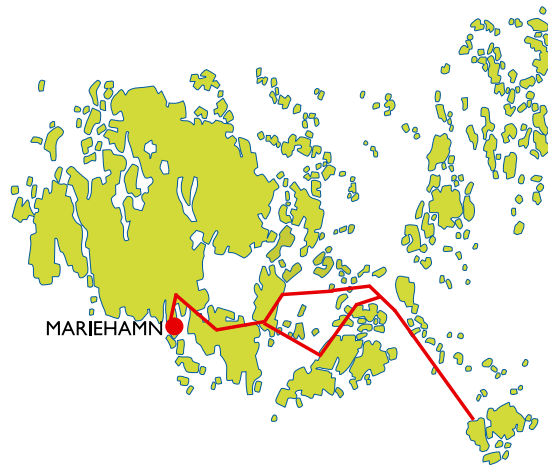

**Day 3** Kumlinge (inter-island ferry, northern line) – Hummelvik, Vårdö – Prästö, stay overnight at Prästö cottages. Approx. 17 km.

Experience distant **Kökar**, with its unique natural landscape.

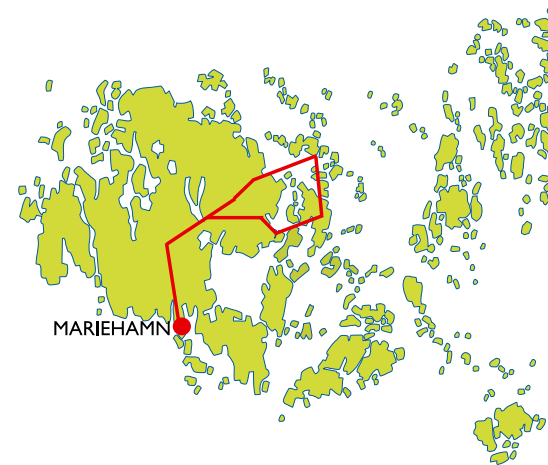

## Seeing things at a leisurely pace

In today's society where things seem to move at a speed we can barely keep up with, it can be an amazing feeling of freedom to sit astride a bicycle and coast along at a leisurely pace. Steady pedalling sets a pleasant tempo, so your senses can easily follow along. Sometimes those slow, repetitive images are all our senses are capable of perceiving.

The highest "peak" on Åland is a modest 129 metres above sea level, so visitors on two wheels don't have to worry about any tough, insurmountable inclines. The numerous well-maintained cycle paths, paved with red granite asphalt, run throughout the island landscape like a network of arteries linked at various points via tranquil, salt-sprayed cycle and inter-island ferries.

Cyclists are generally even more appreciative than most tourists of the fact that the Åland islands have the most hours of sunshine anywhere around the Baltic Sea. But even if there's a howling gale blowing, if it's pouring with rain or you're cycling into a headwind – that's not necessarily all bad. A nice, hot cup of coffee or hot chocolate seldom tastes as good as it does just then, when you've finally reached your destination and can wrap your frozen hands round a warming mug and feel the hot liquid running down into your belly.

All cycling packages include a three-speed bicycle, pannier bag and helmet.

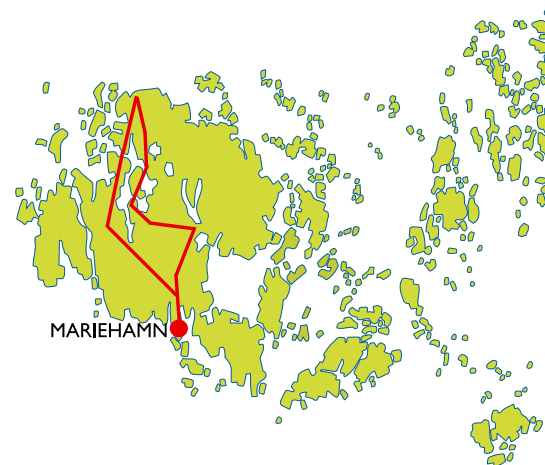

## Countryside and hills

33 + 22 + 35 km

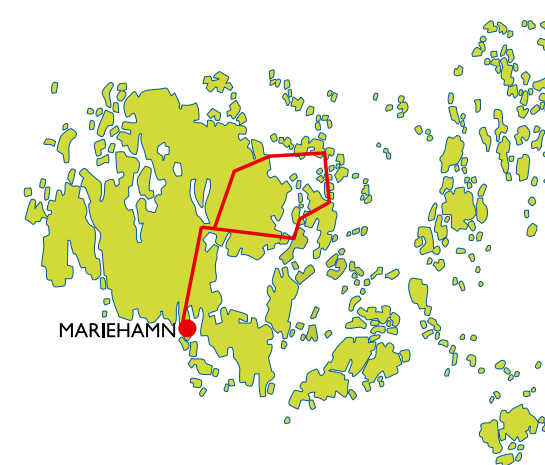
Sunday–Friday 21/6–14/8

**Day 1** Mariehamn – Godby – Pålshöle – Bastö, stay overnight at Bastö Hotell & Stugby. Approx. 33 km.

**Day 2** Bastö – Hällö (bicycle ferry Silvana) – Skarpnätö, stay overnight at Kvarnhagens cottages. Approx. 23 km.

**Day 3** Skarpnätö – Kattby – Mariehamn. Approx. 35 km.

## Castle and islands

35 + 20 + 36 + 28 km

28/6–15/8

**Hardcore cyclists can make it around this route in 2–3 days, but if you want to see a little more of the Åland landscape, you'll want to allow a bit more time. You take the cable ferry to Vårdö and bike ferry between Vårdö and Saltvik. Can be combined with our "Countryside and hills" package, branching off in Godby.**

**Day 1** Mariehamn – Godby – Kastelholm castle – Prästö, stay overnight in Prästö cottages. Approx. 35 km.
